



### CHOOSING YOUR GLUE

There are a number of glues you can use:  
PVA glue, superglue or balsa cement (UHU Hart).



### USING PVA GLUE

Using a good quality PVA, run the glue across the gluing edge and hold firmly in place to establish a bond. The bond will take a few hours to completely dry, so you have time to reposition if necessary.



### USING SUPERGLUE

Superglue will allow quicker builds. Apply the glue along the edge, hold in place, then spray with a superglue accelerator. This instantly sets the bond. Superglue is great for sticking parts with small gluing areas, such as the end of rods.



### USING BALSA CEMENT (UHU HART)

Apply a thin layer to one side. Immediately place the parts together and hold in place. For hard, enclosed surfaces apply a thin layer to both sides, let the adhesive dry, then re-apply to one side, place the parts together and hold in place.
