



CHOOSING YOUR GLUE

PVA glue is commonly used to stick card. There are different grades available. Basic PVA's are thinner with longer drying times. We recommend Hi-Tack glues as they are thicker, dry faster, are clear and flexible; this makes them easier to use.



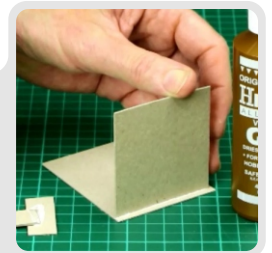
APPLYING YOUR GLUE

To apply the glue, pour some out onto some scrap card first. Then apply the glue to the surface using an off cut of the card or a paint brush. This allows you can apply the glue more accurately along the edge.



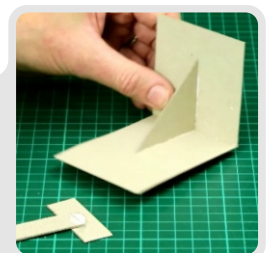
STICKING THE CARD

Once the edge is covered in glue, put the card in place and hold together for a few moments until a bond is achieved.



GETTING THE RIGHT ANGLE

To ensure a right angle between two surfaces, you can glue in a 'former' such as a triangular piece of card.
